Standard Courses For Dinghy Races.

These are recommended courses. Other course may be used if carefully described on the course board.

The **course number**, **number of laps/ race duration** (and whether **average lap time race**.) is to be shown on the course board.

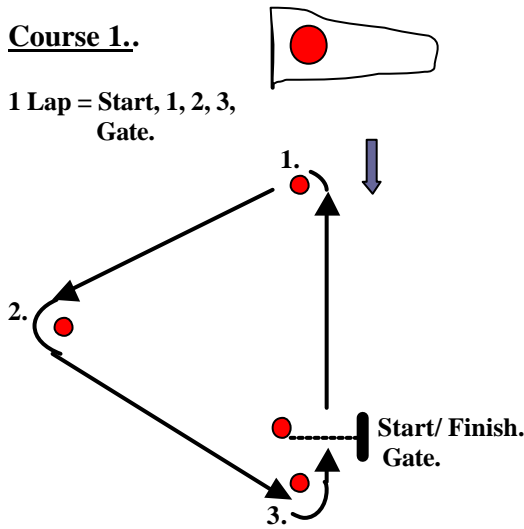
The **course number**, if omitted from the course board, will be displayed from the committee boat with **international code flags** as illustrated below.

The fixed cruiser racing marks, **I, O, H, & M**, and the **Bell Buoy**, may be used as course marks, provided;

- a) they are not being used by the cruiser fleet,
- b) their use is clearly described on the course notice board,

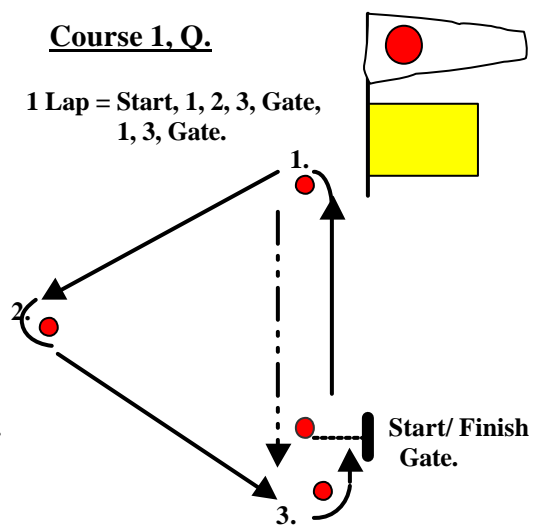
Course 1..

1 Lap = Start, 1, 2, 3, Gate.



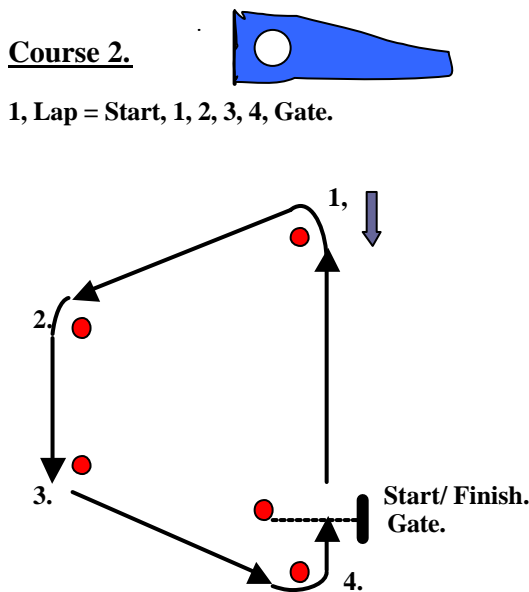
Course 1. Q.

1 Lap = Start, 1, 2, 3, Gate, 1, 3, Gate.



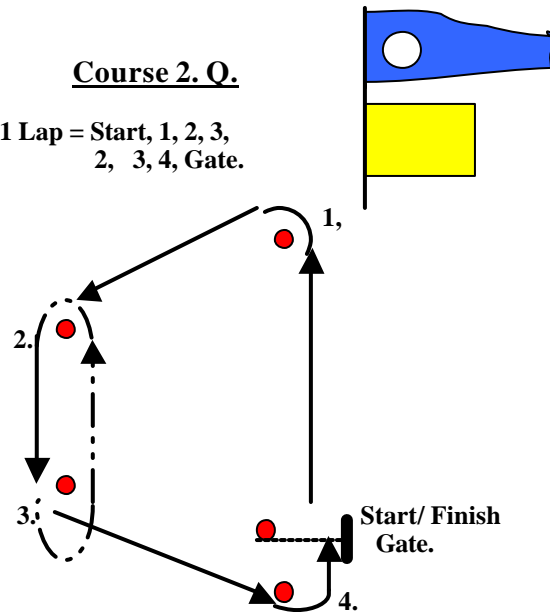
Course 2.

1, Lap = Start, 1, 2, 3, 4, Gate.

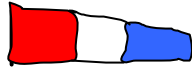


Course 2. Q.

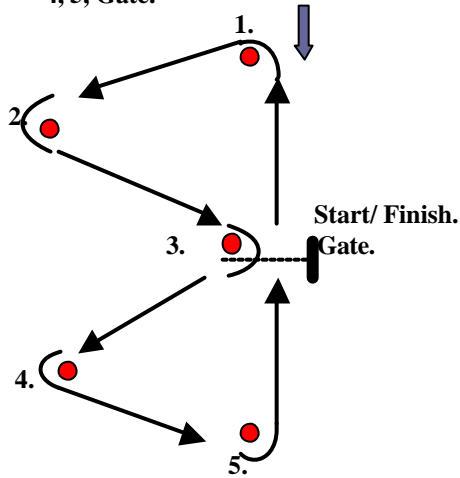
1 Lap = Start, 1, 2, 3, 2, 3, 4, Gate.



Course 3.

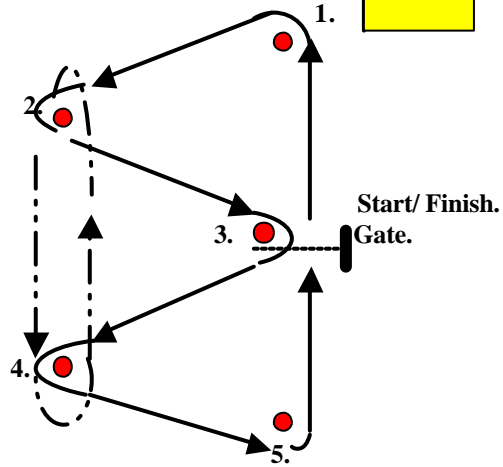
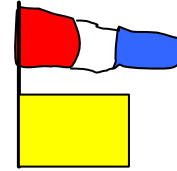


1 Lap = Start, 1, 2, 3 stbd,

Course 3, Q.

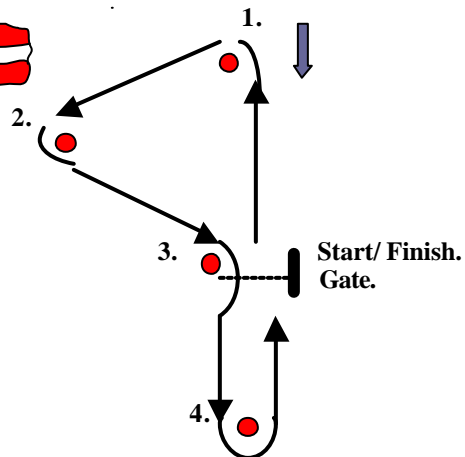
1 lap = 2 rounds,

1, 2, 4, 2, 4, 5, Gate.



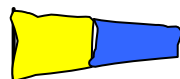
Course 4.



1 Lap = Start, 1, 2, 3 stbd, 4, Gate.

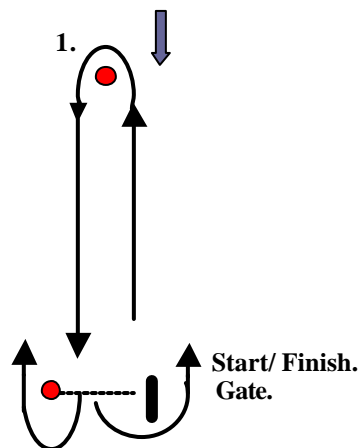


Course 5.

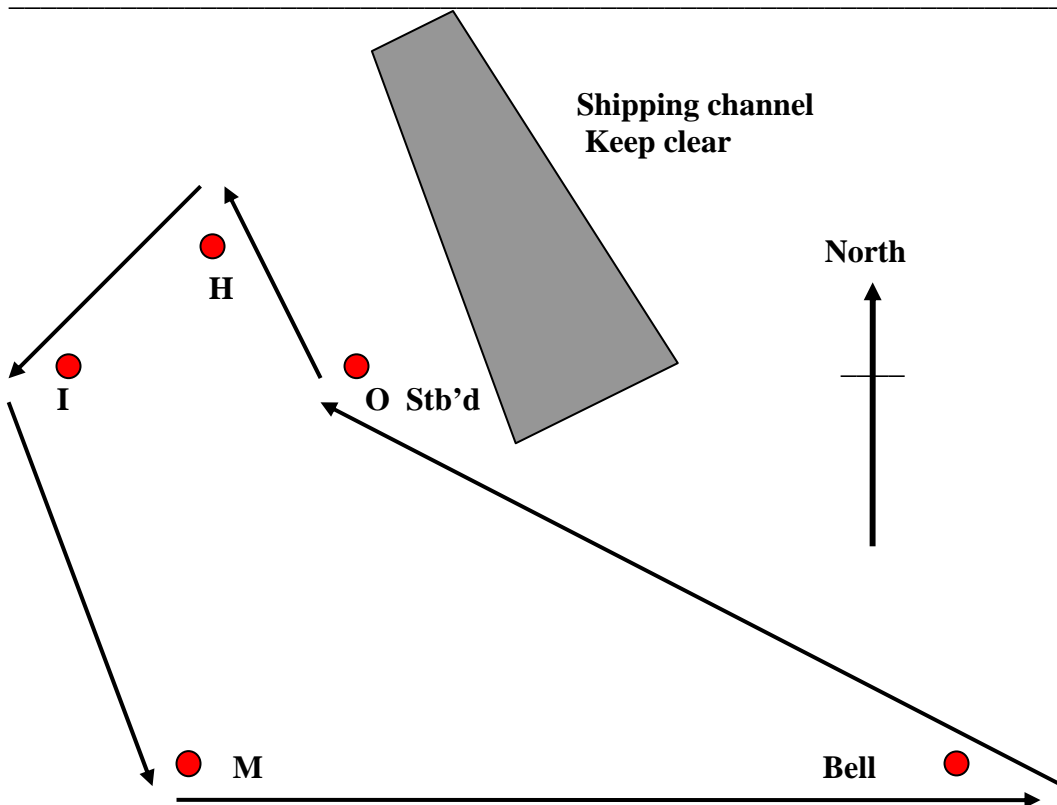
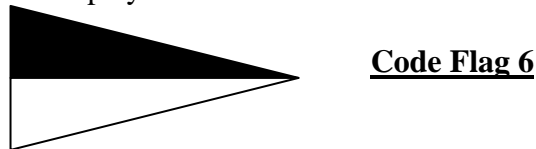
ADDENDUM TO APPENDIX 1. TO THE DINGHY SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
Standard Courses for Dinghy Races.

The standard courses for dinghy races allows the use of the fixed cruiser racing marks **I,O,H,M** and the **Bell Buoy**, as course marks for dinghy races provided ;

- a) They are not being used by the cruiser fleet.
- b) Their use is clearly described on the course notice board.

As the course notice board is no longer used, the following diagram indicates an additional **Standard Course 6**, utilising these marks.

The course number will be displayed from the committee boat with the international code flag 6, illustrated.



Marks H, I, M, & Bell are all rounded to Port. Mark O is rounded to Starboard. Code Flag 6 flown over a Green Flag, indicates that the course is reversed and all marks will be passed on the opposite side to that shown.

A starting gate to be located on the leg which provides a good beat to the first mark. Boats must pass through the starting gate on each lap.

A race will be finished in accordance with S.I. 5.1 & 5.2

This course should not be used when sailing conditions are difficult.
